

Summer Solstice 2023

WEDNESDAY 21 JUNE AT 15:58 BST

Following on from the Spring Equinox in March, our journey around the Sun has continued and we'll soon be arriving at the Summer Solstice on 21 June.

It's the first day of astronomical Summer and this transitional point is a key stage between the seasons of Spring and Summer.

As our Earth travels around the Sun its elliptical orbit has brought us to the furthermost point north of the equator, to Midsummer, to the day we receive our largest dose of daylight and so giving us the 'longest day' and 'shortest night' of our year.

Enjoy the day... as whilst we look forward to the warmer weather that summer can bring we're also now on our way to the Autumnal Equinox on 23 September at o6:50 GMT (07:50 BST), losing approx 2 minutes of daylight each day in the process, and then from there steadily travelling on to the Winter Solstice on 22 December at 03:27 GMT and the shortest day of the year.
